ENGLISH LANGUAGE LEARNERS INFORMATION - REJECT RULES

13. If Survey Period Code is 2 or 3, The English Language Learners: Reclassification Date must be numeric and a valid date less than or equal to the survey date unless zero filled. If Survey Period Code is 5, English Language Learners: Reclassification Date must be numeric and a valid date less than or equal to June 30th unless zero filled. If Survey Period Code is 7, English Language Learners: Reclassification Date must be numeric and a valid date prior to the last day of survey 7 processing or it must be zero filled. -record rejected-

EXAMPLE

The first two records listed below would be added to the data base assuming no other reject rule would cause their rejection. The third and fourth records would be rejected because the English Language Learners: Reclassification Date is invalid and blank, respectively.

DISTRICT RESPONSIBILITY

If the rejected records should not have been submitted, no action is required. However, if the district wishes the data in the rejected records to be loaded to the data base, the district must correct the English Language Learners: Reclassification Date and resubmit the records.

FEDERAL/STATE INDICATOR STATUS - STATE VALIDATION RULES



67. If Survey Period Code is 2, 3 or 5 and there is a matching Exceptional Student record with an Exceptionality, Primary or Exceptionality, Other code other than L and Z; then the Section 504 Eligible code must be Z. The match is based on District Number, Current Enrollment; Student Number Identifier, Florida; Survey Period Code and Fiscal Year/Year. -state validation-

EXAMPLE

The Federal/State Indicator Status record listed below which is marked with an asterisk would cause a message to be generated because the correct relationship does not exist between Section 504 Eligible and Exceptionality, Primary on the Exceptional Student record.

DISTRICT RESPONSIBILITY

The district must correct the records so that the appropriate relationship exists between Section 504 Eligible and Exceptionality, Primary on the Exceptional Student record.

STUDENT COURSE SCHEDULE - REJECT RULES

 54. If the Virtual Instruction Provider code is 301 (Florida Connections Academy, LLC) then Grade Level must be KG-08. If the Virtual Instruction Provider code is 071 (Florida Virtual School) then Grade Level must be 09-12. - record rejected-

EXAMPLE

The first two records listed below would be loaded to the data base assuming no other reject rule would cause their rejection. The third record would be rejected because the Grade Level is not valid for the Virtual Instruction Provider code.

DISTRICT RESPONSIBILITY

If the rejected record should not have been submitted, no action is required. However, if the district wishes the data in the rejected record to be loaded to the data base, the district must correct the Virtual Instruction Provider or the Grade Level and resubmit the record.
