DISTRICT RESPONSIBILITY

The district must review the Dropout Prevention/Juvenile Justice code and Grade Level and correct one of the records if there is an error.

STUDENT DISCIPLINE/REFERRAL ACTION - REJECT RULES

 **2H. School Number, Where Incident Occurred must be numeric in the range 0001 – 9899. -record rejected-**

EXAMPLE

The first two records listed below would be loaded to the data base assuming no other reject rule would cause their rejection. The third record would be rejected because the School Number, Where Incident Occurred is not in the appropriate numerical range. The fourth record would be rejected because the School Number, Where Incident Occurred is not numeric.

DISTRICT RESPONSIBILITY

If the rejected records should not have been submitted, no action is required. However, if the district wishes the data in the rejected records to be loaded to the data base, the district must correct the School Number, Where Incident Occurred and resubmit the records.
