EXAMPLE

The first record listed below would be loaded to the data base assuming no other reject rule would cause its rejection. The second record would be rejected because the relationship between Dual Enrollment Indicator code and FEFP Program Number is not appropriate.

DISTRICT RESPONSIBILITY

If the rejected record should not have been submitted, no action is required. However, if the district wishes the data in the rejected record to be loaded to the data base, the district must correct either the Dual Enrollment Indicator code or FEFP Program Number and resubmit the record.

STUDENT COURSE SCHEDULE - REJECT RULES

45. If the Course Number begins with an alpha character and is on the Course Code Directory file, and the School Number, Current Instruction/Service does not begin with P, the FEFP Program Number must be 103 or 113. -record rejected- ←

Note: Enrollment of secondary students in postsecondary vocational courses must be reported in the Workforce Development Information System. The parallel allowable dual enrollment hours at the high school are to be reported under the same postsecondary vocational course number, but must be funded under the basic program weights of 103 or 113. ←

EXAMPLE

The records listed below would be rejected because the Course Number is for a postsecondary course (begins with an alpha character and the School Number, Current Instruction/Service does not begin with a P) and the FEFP Program Number is not 103 or 113. ←
