STUDENT END OF YEAR STATUS – REJECT RULES

14. If Grade Level is PK-08 then Year Entered Ninth Grade, Graduation Requirements Determination must be 00000000. If Grade Level is 09 or 10 then Year Entered Ninth Grade, Graduation Requirements Determination must be greater than zero. -record rejected-

EXAMPLE

The first, third, fifth and sixth records listed below would be loaded to the data base assuming no other reject rule would cause their rejection. The second record would be rejected because Year Entered Ninth Grade, Graduation Requirements Determination is not all zeros for a student in Grade Level 08. The fourth record would be rejected because the Year Entered Ninth Grade, Graduation Requirements Determination is all zeros for a student in Grade Level 09.

DISTRICT RESPONSIBILITY

However, if the district wishes the data in the rejected records to be loaded to the data base, the district should correct the Year Entered Ninth Grade, Graduation Requirements Determination or the Grade Level and resubmit the records.
