TITLE I SUPPLEMENTAL EDUCATIONAL SERVICES – EXCEPTION REPORT

 80. If Survey Period Code equals 2, 9 or 5 each Title I Supplemental Educational Services format record must have a matching Student Demographic format record with a Lunch Status code of 2, 3, or 4. If Survey Period Code is 3 and Title I Supplemental Educational Services – Begin Services Date is equal to or less than the last day of survey 3 survey week, then the record must have a matching Student Demographic format record with a Lunch Status code of 2, 3, or 4. -exception report -

EXAMPLE

The first Title I Supplemental Educational Services record listed below would pass the edit because it has a matching Student Demographic record with Lunch Status Code 2, 3 or 4. The second Title I Supplemental Educational Services record listed below which is marked with an asterisk would cause an error message to be generated because the Lunch Status code is not 2, 3 or 4.
