<p>An indicator that the migrant student has been classified as failing or at risk of failing to meet the state achievement requirements and that the student's education has been interrupted during the regular school year leading to the designation of "priority to receive services." Students Identified as "Priority for Services" must receive services prior to migrant funds being utilized for other migrant children. The following indicators shall be used to identify the children who should receive "Priority for Services".</p> <p>The migrant student who:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Scored at Level 1 or Level 2 on the FCAT; or • Is an English Language Learner *; or • Was retained at any time; or • Has an age/grade discrepancy; or • Is at risk of failing to meet the state graduation requirement by having one or both of the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ an unweighted GPA of 2.0 or below, or ○ insufficient credits for promotion or graduation. <p>AND</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Whose education has been interrupted during the regular school year. An "educational interruption" occurs when a child, in the preceding 12 months, has changed schools or missed a "significant" amount of school time (e.g. ten days or more) during the regular school year (defined as August through June) due to the child's or family's migrant lifestyle. DISTRICT RESPONSIBILITY

If the rejected record should not have been submitted, no action is required. However, if the district wishes the data in the rejected record to be loaded to the data base, the district must correct the FEFP Program Number and resubmit the record.

STUDENT END OF YEAR STATUS - STATE VALIDATION

45. If Grade Promotion Status: Good Cause Exemption equals 2; then there must be a matching Exceptional Student record where one of the two elements Exceptionality, Primary or Exceptionality, Other does not equal L or Z. The records should match based on District Number, Current Enrollment; School Number, Current Enrollment; Student Number, Identifier; Survey, and Year. - state validation-

DISTRICT RESPONSIBILITY

The district must correct the Student End of Year Status record or the Exceptional Student record so that the appropriate relationship exists between Grade Promotion Status: Good Cause Exemption and Exceptionality, Primary or Exceptionality, Other.

STUDENT END OF YEAR STATUS - STATE VALIDATION

4G. If Diploma Type = W07 or W27, then Exceptionality, Primary on the Exceptional Student record must be C, G, H, J, K, O, P, S, V or W. The match between the Student End of Year Status record and the Exceptional Student record should use the following fields: District Number, Current Enrollment;  School Number, Current Enrollment; Student Number Identifier, Florida; Survey Period Code; and Year. –state validation-
