EXCEPTIONAL STUDENT - REJECT RULES

2A. Exceptionality, Other must be unique other than Z. -record rejected-

Note: Nine possible codes may be selected but must not be duplicated. If fewer than nine codes are selected, Z-fill the remaining fields.

EXAMPLE

The first record listed below would be loaded to the data base assuming no other reject rule would cause its rejection. The second and third records would be rejected because the Exceptionality, Other code is duplicated.

DISTRICT RESPONSIBILITY

If the rejected records should not have been submitted, no action is required. However, if the district wishes the data in the rejected records to be loaded to the data base, the district must correct the Exceptionality, Other codes and resubmit the records.

STUDENT COURSE TRANSCRIPT INFORMATION - REJECT RULES

29. Course Substituted, State Subject Area Requirements must equal EN, MA, SC, AH, WH, EC, AG, VO, SV, PF, LM, PE, EX, EL, FL, LA, SS, NC, CE, or PA. -record rejected-

In the example below, the first record would be loaded to the data base assuming no other reject rule would cause it to be rejected. The second record would be rejected since the Course Substituted, State Subject Area Requirements code is invalid.

DISTRICT RESPONSIBILITY

The district must correct the Grade Level on the Student Demographic record or the Student Course record, so that the correct Grade Level for that student is on both record types.
