## VOCATIONAL STUDENT COURSE SCHEDULE - REJECT RULES

8. If the School Number, Current Instruction/Service does not begin with C, P or U or if the Course Number does not begin with an alphabetic character or if the Course Number is not all zeros, then the Vocational/Adult General Education Program Code must be a secondary program number from the Vocational/Adult General Education Program Edit file (F61730). If the School Number, Current Instruction/Service begins with C, P or U or if the Course Number begins with an alphabetic character, then the Vocational/Adult General Education Program Code must be a secondary program number from the Vocational/Adult General Education Program Edit file (F61730) or it must be all zeros. If the Course Number is all zeros, then the Vocational/Adult General Education Program Code must be all zeros. -record rejected-

Note: For more information on Vocational/Adult General Education Program Codes refer to the Vocational Data Base Handbook Appendices.

### EXAMPLE

The first and second records listed below would be loaded to the data base assuming no other reject rule would cause their rejection. The third record would be rejected because the Vocational/Adult General Education Program Code is not a valid program number. The fourth record would be rejected because the Vocational/Adult General Education Program Code is not a secondary vocational program code.

If the rejected record should not have been submitted, no action is required. However, if the district wishes the data in the rejected records to be loaded to the data base, the district must correct the Vocational/Adult General Education Program Code and resubmit the records.

## VOCATIONAL STUDENT COURSE SCHEDULE - REJECT RULES

9. Course Number must not contain blanks. If School Number, Current Instruction/Service does not begin with C, P or U and if the Course Number does not begin with an alphabetic character and if the Course Number is not all zeros; then the Course Number must be a valid Course Number on the Vocational/Adult General Education Program Edit file (DPS.DISTRICT.GQ.F61730.Yyyyy). If School Number, Current Instruction/Service begins with C or U and if the Course Number is not all zeros, then the Course Number must be on the Statewide Course Numbering System file. -record rejected-

Note: DPS.DISTRICT.GQ.F61730.Yyyyy contains valid secondary vocational and applicable exceptional education course numbers. These do not include "local use only" transfer courses. Course Code Directory number ranges for vocational education programs and courses are also listed in Appendix D of the Secondary Vocational Data Base Handbook.

### EXAMPLE

The third record listed below would be loaded to the data base assuming no other reject rule would cause its rejection. The first and second records would be rejected because the Course Number contains blanks or it is a "local use only transfer" course. The fourth record would be rejected because the Course Number is not a secondary vocational Course Number.

## VOCATIONAL STUDENT COURSE SCHEDULE - REJECT RULES

→ **4B. If Course Number is all zeros, then Industry Certification Identifier (First) must not be all Zs. -record rejected-**

The first two records listed below would be loaded to the data base assuming no other edit would cause their rejection. The third record would be rejected because the Industry Certification Identifier must not be all Zs if Course Number is all zeros.

If the rejected record should not have been submitted, no action is required. However, if the district wishes the data in the rejected record to be loaded to the data base, the district must correct the Course Number or the Industry Certification Identifier (First) and resubmit the record.



## VOCATIONAL STUDENT COURSE SCHEDULE - REJECT RULES

→ **4C. If Course Number is all zeros, then FEFP Program Number must be 999 and Term, Vocational/Adult General Education Completion Point Code, Modified Occupational Completion Point and Exceptional Student Vocational Course Setting must be Z-filled. -record rejected-**

The first two records listed below would be loaded to the data base assuming no other edit would cause their rejection. The third record would be rejected because FEFP Program Number must be 999 if Course number is all zeros.

### DISTRICT RESPONSIBILITY

If the rejected record should not have been submitted, no action is required. However, if the district wishes the data in the rejected record to be loaded to the data base, the district must correct the Course Number or FEFP Program Number and resubmit the record.

## VOCATIONAL STUDENT COURSE SCHEDULE - STATE VALIDATION RULES

50. If School Number, Current Instruction/Service does not begin with C, P or U or if School Year – Course Taken is the same as School Year – Record Submission or if Course Number is not zero; then each Vocational Student Course record must have a matching Vocational Teacher Course record based on the key fields of District Number, Current Instruction/Service; School Number, Current Instruction/Service; School Year – Record Submitted; Course Number; Section Number; Period Number and Term. -state validation-

### EXAMPLE

The first and second records listed below would pass the edit criteria. However, the third Vocational Student Course Schedule record would not pass this edit because of the failure to have a matching Vocational Teacher Course Schedule based on the keys of District Number, Current Instruction/Service; School Number, Current Instruction/Service; School Year – Record Submitted; Course Number; Section Number; Period Number and Term.

## VOCATIONAL STUDENT COURSE SCHEDULE - EXCEPTION REPORTS

63. If the Course Number is not 8502000 or 00000000, then the FEFP Program Number must be 300, 102, 103, 112, 113, 254 or 255. -exception report-

### EXAMPLE

The first record listed below meets the criteria specified in the above edit. The second and third records would cause a message to be generated because the FEFP Program Number is not the expected FEFP Program Number for the Course Number reported.
