28. If School Number, Current Instruction/Service is not 9994, then it must exist on the Master School Identification File as a valid active school in the district of instruction. -record rejected-

EXAMPLE

The fourth and fifth records listed below would be loaded to the data base assuming no other reject rule would cause their rejection. Records one, two and three would be rejected because the School Number, Current Instruction/Service do not exist on the Master School Identification File as valid active school numbers in the district of instruction.

2H. If Survey Period Code is 5, and If English Language Learners: Basis of Entry is code A and If English Language Learners: Exit Date is 00000000 then at least one of the four Test Names must be other than ZZZ. —record rejected-
