## STUDENT DEMOGRAPHIC – REJECT RULES

 **1E. If School Number, Current Enrollment is 7004 then Grade Level must be 06 through 12. -record rejected-**

### EXAMPLE

The first two records listed below would be written to the data base assuming no other reject rule would cause their rejection. The third record would be rejected since the Grade Level is not in the appropriate range.

### DISTRICT RESPONSIBILITY
