EXCEPTIONAL STUDENT - STATE VALIDATION/NULL EDIT RULES

- 35. If Survey Period Code is 2, 3 or 5 and Gifted Eligibility on the Exceptional Student format equals A or B, then Exceptional Student Eligibility Determination Date on the Exceptional Student Program format must be equal to or greater than 07012009. The records should be matched based on the following fields: District Number, Current Enrollment; Student Number Identifier, Florida; Fiscal Year and Survey Period Code and the Exceptionality on the Exceptional Student Program record should be L. Also, if no matching record exists an error message should be generated. –state validation–

EXAMPLE

The Exceptional Student records listed below which are marked with an asterisk would cause an error message to be generated because the correct relationship does not exist between Gifted Eligibility and Exceptional Student Eligibility Determination Date.

DISTRICT RESPONSIBILITY

The district must correct the records so that the appropriate relationship exists between Gifted Eligibility and Exceptional Student Eligibility Determination Date.

STUDENT COURSE SCHEDULE - REJECT RULES

- 57. If School Number, Current Instruction/Service is 7001, then the Virtual Instruction Provider code must be a valid code in Appendix CC. If School Number, Current Instruction/Service is not 7001, then the Virtual Instruction Provider code must be ZZZ. -record rejected-

EXAMPLE

The first two records listed below would be loaded to the data base assuming no other reject rule would cause their rejection. The third record would be rejected because the Virtual Instruction Provider code is not valid for the School Number, Current Instruction/Service.

DISTRICT RESPONSIBILITY

If the rejected record should not have been submitted, no action is required. However, if the district wishes the data in the rejected record to be loaded to the data base, the district must correct the Virtual Instruction Provider or the School Number, Current Instruction/Service and resubmit the record.
