DROPOUT PREVENTION PROGRAM DATA - REJECT RULES

6. If Dropout Prevention/Juvenile Justice Programs code is U, R, A, E, P or D, then Dropout Prevention Program Enrollment Date must be numeric, a valid date, greater than or equal to 07/01/**** and less than 08/31/****. If Dropout Prevention/Juvenile Justice Programs code is N, then Dropout Prevention Program Enrollment Date must be numeric, a valid date, greater than 07/01/1986 and less than 08/31/****. -record rejected-

EXAMPLE

The first two records listed below would be loaded to the data base assuming no other reject rule would cause their rejection. The third record would be rejected because the Dropout Prevention Program Enrollment Date is not numeric. The fourth record would be rejected because the Dropout Prevention Program Enrollment Date is an invalid date.
