DROPOUT PREVENTION PROGRAM DATA - REJECT RULES

6. If Dropout Prevention/Juvenile Justice Programs code is U, R, A, E, P or D, then Dropout Prevention Program Enrollment Date must be numeric, a valid date, greater than or equal to 07/01/**** and less than 08/31/****. If Dropout Prevention/Juvenile Justice Programs code is N, then Dropout Prevention Program Enrollment Date must be numeric, a valid date, greater than 07/01/1987 and less than 08/31/****. -record rejected-

EXAMPLE

The first two records listed below would be loaded to the data base assuming no other reject rule would cause their rejection. The third record would be rejected because the Dropout Prevention Program Enrollment Date is not numeric. The fourth record would be rejected because the Dropout Prevention Program Enrollment Date is an invalid date.

If the rejected records should not have been submitted, no action is required. However, if the district wishes the data in the rejected records to be loaded to the data base, the district must correct the Dropout Prevention Program Enrollment Date and resubmit the records.

VOCATIONAL STUDENT COURSE SCHEDULE - REJECT RULES

7. The School Number, Current Instruction/Service must be numeric in the range 0001-9899, or it must be C901-C928, U970-U980, or P001-P999. -record rejected-

EXAMPLE

The records listed below would be rejected. The first record would be rejected because the School Number, Current Instruction/Service is not within the valid range of numbers. The second record would be rejected because the School Number, Current Instruction/Service contains two blanks.

VOCATIONAL STUDENT COURSE SCHEDULE - REJECT RULES

8. If the School Number, Current Instruction/Service does not begin with C, P or U or if the Course Number does not begin with an alphabetic character, then the Vocational/Adult General Education Program Code must be a secondary program number from the Vocational/Adult General Education Program Edit file (F61730). If the School Number, Current Instruction/Service begins with C, P or U or if the Course Number begins with an alphabetic character, then the Vocational/Adult General Education Program Code must be a secondary program number from the Vocational/Adult General Education Program Edit file (F61730) or it must be all zeros. . -record rejected-

Note: For more information on Vocational/Adult General Education Program Codes refer to the Vocational Data Base Handbook Appendices.

EXAMPLE

The first and second records listed below would be loaded to the data base assuming no other reject rule would cause their rejection. The third record would be rejected because the Vocational/Adult General Education Program Code is not a valid program number. The fourth record would be rejected because the Vocational/Adult General Education Program Code is not a secondary vocational program code.

VOCATIONAL STUDENT COURSE SCHEDULE - REJECT RULES

→ 9. Course Number must not contain blanks. If School Number, Current Instruction/Service does not begin with C, P or U or if the Course Number does not begin with an alphabetic character; then the Course Number must be a valid secondary Vocational Course Number (other than "local use only transfer" courses) on the Vocational/Adult General Education Program Edit file (F61730), or an applicable exceptional education course number on the Vocational/Adult General Education Program Edit file (F61730). (See Vocational Data Base Handbook Appendices for a list of valid Course Code Directory courses.) If School Number, Current Instruction/Service begins with C or U, then the Course Number must be on the Statewide Course Numbering System file) -record rejected-

EXAMPLE

The third record listed below would be loaded to the data base assuming no other reject rule would cause its rejection. The first and second records would be rejected because the Course Number contains blanks or it is a "local use only transfer" course. The fourth record would be rejected because the Course Number is not a secondary vocational Course Number.

VOCATIONAL STUDENT COURSE SCHEDULE - STATE VALIDATION RULES

→ 50. If School Number, Current Instruction/Service does not begin with C, P or U; then each Vocational Student Course record must have a matching Vocational Teacher Course record based on the key fields of District Number, Current Instruction/Service; School Number, Current Instruction/Service; School Year; Course Number; Section Number; Period Number and Term. -state validation-

EXAMPLE

The first and second records listed below would pass the edit criteria. However, the third Vocational Student Course Schedule record would not pass this edit because of the failure to have a matching Vocational Teacher Course Schedule based on the keys of District Number, Current Instruction/Service; School Number, Current Instruction/Service; School Year; Course Number; Section Number; Period Number and Term.

VOCATIONAL STUDENT COURSE SCHEDULE - STATE VALIDATION RULES

DISTRICT RESPONSIBILITY

The district must correct the appropriate key field on the Vocational Student Course records or submit a matching Vocational Teacher Course record.

2008-2009 Student Assessment

1. Submit student assessment records during reporting periods 2, 3 and 5 for students in KG-12 membership who have been targeted for reading intervention consistent with the district's K-12 Comprehensive Reading Plan. Generally, report three scores a year; one in October, one in February and one at the end of the year. Send only assessment information that has not been sent in a previous reporting period and only assessment information that is not being reported via the Progress Monitoring and Reporting Network (PMRN).
- 2. TEST SCORE: Submit up to two Test Score/Test Score Type combinations for the Test Subject Content area being reported. Zeroes may be a valid test score. If only one Test Score is being submitted on a record, report all zeroes for the second Test Score.
- 3. TEST SCORE TYPES: For standardized tests, submit a normal curve equivalent (NC) for the first Test Score Type/Test Score combination and a scale score (SS) for the second Test Score Type/Test Score combination or a lexile score (LX) for the first Test Score Type/Test Score combination and a national percentile (NP) for the second Test Score Type/Test Score combination.
- 4. TEST FORM: If no Test Form applies report 'Z' in this field.
- 5. TEST LEVEL: If no Test Level applies, report 'ZZ' in this field.
- 6. ERROR CODES: This field is used by the Department to report to districts the specific errors found in the record during the state edit process. This field should contain filler (spaces, blanks) when the record is transmitted to the Department.
- 7. KEY FIELDS: The key fields for this format are items 1-6, 8 and 9.

2008-2009 Vocational Student Course Schedule

1. Submit a separate record in reporting period 5 for each vocational and applicable vocational exceptional education course in which the student was in membership during the current school year and the associated summer session(s) for the current school year. Include dual enrollment courses if the student took an industry certification or technical skill assessment listed in Appendix Z that is related to the dual enrollment course.
2. **INDUSTRY CERTIFICATION IDENTIFIER:** Report the Industry Certification Identifier from Appendix Z for students who took or attempted an industry certification or technical skill attainment assessment in an area that applies to the course in which the student participated. If none of these are applicable, submit all Z's in this field.
3. **KEY FIELDS:** The key fields for this format are item numbers 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10 and 11. If a key field needs to be changed, the record must be deleted and re-submitted as an add. For item number 8, Course Number, the range of valid values may be found in Secondary Vocational Data Base Handbook: Appendix D.
4. **ERROR CODES:** This field is used by the Department to report to districts the specific errors found in the record during the state edit process. This field should contain filler (spaces, blanks) when the record is transmitted to the Department.
