STUDENT COURSE TRANSCRIPT INFORMATION - REJECT RULES

➔ 13. Course, State Subject Area Requirements must equal EN, MA, SC, AH, WH, EC, AG, VO, SV, PF, LM, PE, EX, EL, FL, LA, SS, NC, CE, or PA. -record rejected-

EXAMPLE

In the example below, records number two, five, six, and seven would be loaded to the data base assuming no other reject rule would cause the records to be rejected. Records one, three and four would be rejected since the Course, State Subject Area Requirements codes are invalid.
