Dual enrollment records are those with School Number, Current Instruction/Service of C901-C928, U970-U980 or P001-P999. -state validation 3-

#### EXAMPLE

The first Teacher Course Schedule record listed below would pass this edit because it has a matching Staff Demographic Information record based on District Number, Current Instruction/Service; Survey Period Code; Fiscal Year and Social Security Number. The second Teacher Course Schedule record listed below would cause a state validation error report message to be generated because there is no matching Staff Demographic Information record.
