ENGLISH LANGUAGE LEARNERS INFORMATION - REJECT RULES

→ 65. If Survey Period Code is 2, 3 or 5 and English Language Learners: Basis of Exit (Second) code is not Z, then English Language Learners: Basis of Exit (First) code must be A, B, C, D, E, F, G or L. -record rejected-

EXAMPLE

The first and second records listed below would be added to the data base assuming no other reject rule would cause their rejection. The third record would be rejected because the English Language Learners: Basis of Exit (First) code is not valid when the ELL Basis of Exit (Second) code is not Z. ←

DISTRICT RESPONSIBILITY

If the rejected record should not have been submitted, no action is required. However, if the district wishes the data in the rejected record to be loaded to the data base, the district must correct the English Language Learners: Basis of Exit (First) or the English Language Learners: Basis of Exit (Second) and resubmit the record. ←
