## ENGLISH LANGUAGE LEARNERS INFORMATION - REJECT RULES

 **2D If English Language Learners: Exit Date is greater than zero and Test Name Reading is CEL and Test Date: Reading is greater than the English Language Learners: Entry Date, then Test Form must not be 3. – record rejected-**

### EXAMPLE

The first record listed below would be loaded to the data base assuming no other reject rule would cause its rejection. The second record would be rejected because the Test Form should not be 3 for an English Language Learner: Exit Date that is greater than zero and where the Test Date: Reading is greater than the English Language Learners: Entry Date.
