## Florida's Single-Year Dropout Rates

Florida's single-year dropout rate is the percentage of high school students that dropout in any one year. More specifically, it is the ninth- through twelfth-grade dropouts compared to the ninth- through twelfth-grade total, year-long student enrollment. A dropout is defined as a student who withdraws from school for any of several reasons without transferring to another school, home education program or adult education program. The definitions for a dropout are listed below in Exhibit 2.

Florida's ninth- through twelfth-grade, single-year dropout rate has fluctuated slightly over the past five years from a high of 2.0 percent in 2009-10 and 2012-13 to a low of 1.8 percent in 2014-15. **Exhibit 1: Grades 9-12 Single-Year Dropout Rates, 2009-10 through 2014-15**

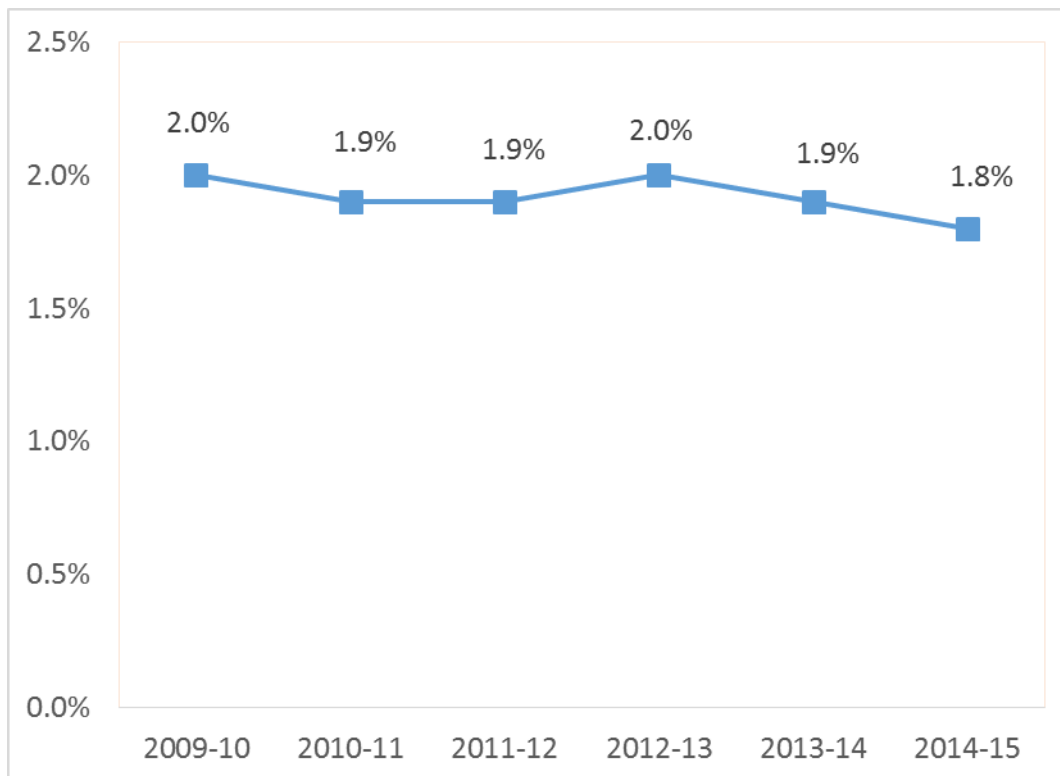

**Exhibit 2: Dropout Withdrawal Codes and Definitions**

DNE - Any PK-12 student who was expected to attend a school but did not enter as expected for unknown reasons
W05 - Any student age 16 or older who leaves school voluntarily with no intention of returning
W13 - Any PK-12 student withdrawn from school due to court action
W15 - Any PK-12 student who is withdrawn from school due to nonattendance
W18 - Any PK-12 student who withdraws from school due to medical reasons
W21 - Any PK-12 student who is withdrawn from school due to being expelled
W22 - Any PK-12 student whose whereabouts is unknown
W23 – Any PK-12 student who withdraws from school for any reason other than W01 - W22 or W24 – W27

## Graduation Rate versus Dropout Rate

Florida's single-year dropout rate is not an inverse of Florida's graduation rate. The differences are as follows:

The rates apply to different periods of time.

- Florida's graduation rate is a four-year, cohort-based indicator.
- Florida's single-year dropout rate is a one-year indicator.

The rates apply to different populations.

- Florida's graduation rate follows the progress of a group of students who entered grade 9 at the same time over a four-year period.
- Single-year dropout rate identifies **all** ninth- through twelfth-grade students in **one** year.

The single year dropout rate and four-year cohort dropout rate are compared in Exhibit 7. The four-year cohort dropout rate is the percent of students who entered the 9<sup>th</sup> grade at the same time and who did not earn a diploma, a GED, Certificate of Completion, or were not found still enrolled in school four years later.
