Annualized earnings in this graph are an estimation based on Florida full-time employment during the $4^{\text {th }}$ quarter of 2018. The data does not include individuals found continuing education. Full-time employment is determined when an individual's $4^{\text {th }}$ quarter wages are equal to at least the hourly minimum wage of $\$ 8.25$, working 40 hours per week, for 13 weeks x 4 quarters, or $\$ 17,160$ annually.

The High Skill/High Wage threshold uses the same calculation but with an hourly minimum wage of $\$ 22.55$ or \$46,904 annually.
