Full Qtr earnings are displayed when 10 or more graduates are employed full quarter.

Continuing education outcomes are based on enrollment data for the fall semester of 2014 and preliminary winter/spring semester of 2015.

Students may be in multiple programs; therefore the details may exceed the total unduplicated count.
