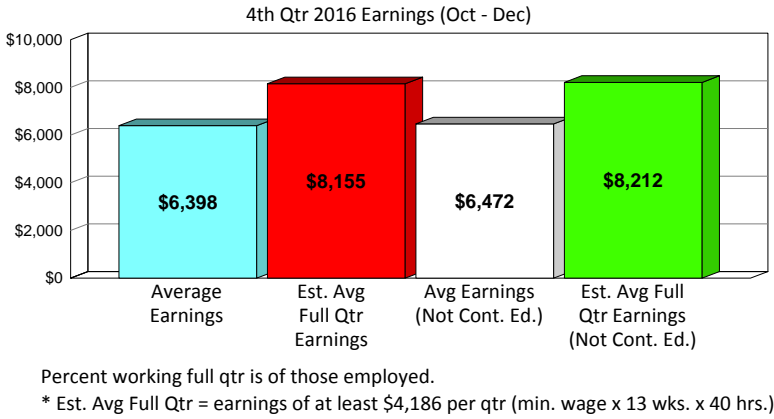
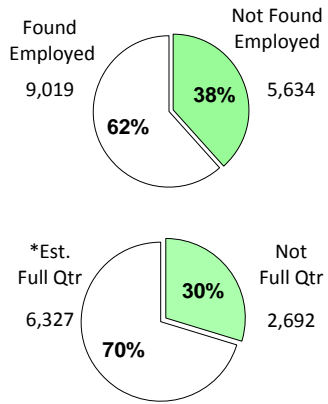

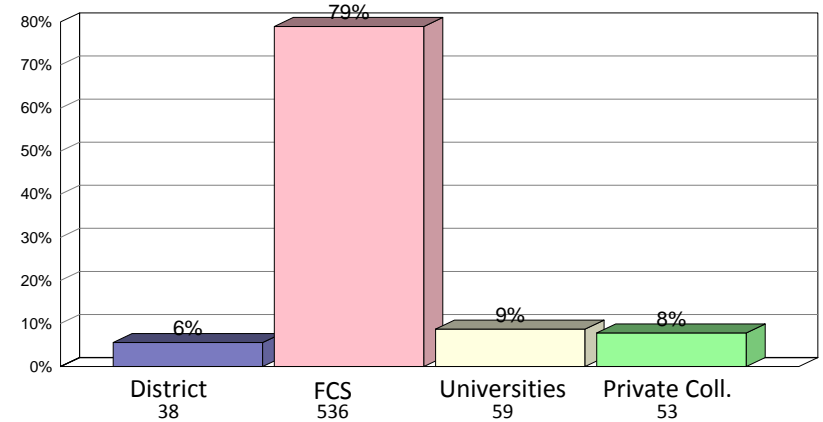
FLORIDA EMPLOYMENT DATA (4th QTR)

 Total Continuing Education & Found Employed: 503 74%



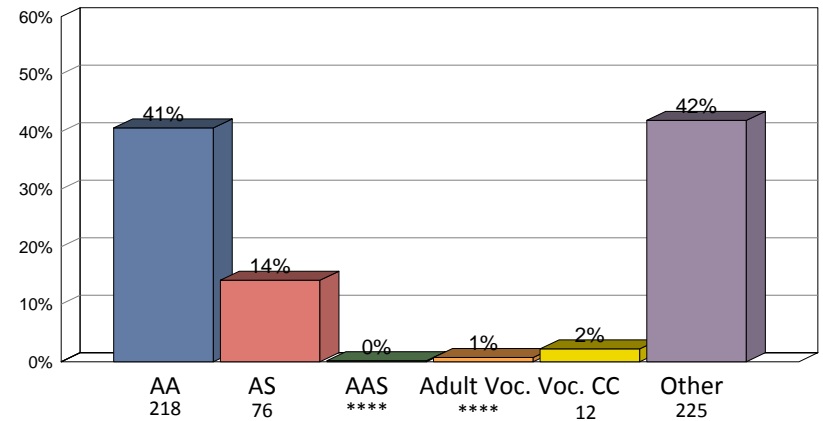
