Student Eligibility (S. 1002.455, F.S.)

□ A student is eligible to participate in virtual instruction if:

- The student spent the prior school year in a Florida public school and was reported for funding during the October and February surveys
- The student is a military dependent who moved to Florida within the last year
- The student was enrolled during the prior school year in a full-time virtual instruction program
- The student has a sibling currently enrolled in a virtual instruction program and who was enrolled in that program at the end of the prior school year;
- The student is eligible to enter kindergarten or first grade
- The student is eligible to enter grades 2 through 5 and is enrolling full-time in a school district virtual instruction program, virtual charter school, or the Florida Virtual School.

Virtual Program Funding

- ❑ Based on Successful Completion
- ❑ Full-time programs can report FTE in all FEFP programs
- ❑ Part-time programs can report FTE for Basic Education and Career Education only
- ❑ Average Virtual Education contribution 2012-13 - \$5,200 per successful completion

HB 7063 – Digital Learning

- ❑ Authorized Florida Virtual School to provide part-time instruction for K-5 students
- ❑ Added grade levels to part-time VIP
- ❑ Provided two exemptions for online graduation requirement
- ❑ Expanded student eligibility to include grades 2-5 students enrolling in full-time virtual programs
- ❑ Required full-time virtual programs to assume responsibilities of a school district for ESE students
