Florida's Multi-Tiered System of Support (MTSS) Recognized Schools Process

The Problem Solving and Response to Intervention (PS/RtI) discretionary project encourages districts to support their schools in applying to become a Florida MTSS Recognized School. Beginning this school year (2020-2021), the PS/RtI Project launched a new initiative to recognize schools creating and implementing practices that are positively impacting student outcomes through building and sustaining an effective MTSS framework. During the application process, each school will reflect on their MTSS implementation, identify promising practices, and discuss positive changes to student outcomes as a result of their MTSS work.
