


## Florida College System institutions offer \$10,000 baccalaureate degrees

Twenty-four baccalaureate-granting colleges in the Florida College System stepped up to Governor Rick Scott's \$10,000 degree challenge to offer select degrees that meet local and community needs while costing students no more than \$10,000. As of spring 2014, nine colleges reported implementing \$10,000 baccalaureate degrees: Broward College, Chipola College, College of Central Florida, Gulf Coast State College, Indian River State College, Miami Dade College, Northwest Florida State College, Polk

State College and Seminole State College of Florida. In fall 2014, 11 additional colleges will offer \$10,000 bachelor's degrees: Eastern Florida State College, Edison State College, Florida State College at Jacksonville, Palm Beach State College, Pasco-Hernando State College, Pensacola State College, St. Johns River State College, St. Petersburg College, Santa Fe College, South Florida State College, and State College of Florida, Manatee-Sarasota. Other colleges that have future plans to offer their regions \$10,000 bachelor's degrees include Daytona State College, Florida Gateway College, Lake-Sumter State College, and Valencia College.
