

Seventeen Florida College System institutions were listed as Top 100 Associate Degree Producers Nationwide in 2013

Seventeen of the 28 Florida College System (FCS) institutions were listed among *Community College Week's* (CC Week) "Top 100 Associate Degree Producers." CC Week noted, "Although Florida ranks fourth in population, it conferred more associate degrees and shorter-term certificates than the larger states of Texas and New York." In 2011-12, the FCS collectively awarded 62,614 associate in arts degrees and 14,953 associate in applied science and associate in science degrees, totaling 77,567.

The FCS also awarded 23,135 certificates during the same period. When including Education Preparation Institute and baccalaureate graduates, the FCS boasted 105,762 completions, which is an all-time high for the system. Year after year the accomplishments of FCS students and institutions are consistently well-represented on CC Week's "Top 100 Associate Degree Producer" list.
