


## The Florida College System is the preferred destination for recent high school graduates

Six out of 10 (N = 93,704) 2010-11 high school graduates (N = 155,132) went on to postsecondary education in Florida during the next year. Nearly two-thirds (N = 61,290) of the direct-transitioning high school graduates entering Florida postsecondary education enrolled in a Florida College System (FCS) institution. Compare this to 31.1 percent (N = 29,156) who enrolled in a State University System school, 5.1 percent (N = 4,809) in an institution with the Independent Colleges or Universities of Florida, or 2.4 percent (N = 2,259) in PK-12 Adult Programs. (Note: students may be enrolled in more than one sector in the same year.) Most recent high school graduates who continued their education chose to start their higher education careers at an FCS institution.
