




Florida's Statewide Articulation Agreement: Providing a Seamless Pathway to the Baccalaureate Degree



Start your future in the Florida College System. Go ANYWHERE.

Florida's higher education system is designed to allow students to successfully pursue a baccalaureate degree by first earning an Associate in Arts (AA) degree at a Florida College System (FCS) [institution](#) and then transferring to a four-year institution (2+2). AA graduates are guaranteed the opportunity to earn a bachelor's degree at a state university (SUS) or Florida college offering four-year degrees. There are also statewide agreements that help AA graduates transfer to non-public universities and select Associate in Science (AS) graduates transition into related baccalaureate programs.
