¹On January 6, 2016, the State Board of Education adopted Achievement Levels for the Florida Standards Assessment (FSA). The Spring 2015 FSA scores were reported to students as percentile scores, and results from the initial release are now being provided based on the new score scale and established Achievement Levels so that stakeholders are able to see what they would have been if the achievement standards had been implemented at that time.

²To provide meaningful results and to protect the privacy of individual students, data are not reported when the total number of students in a group is fewer than 10 or when all the students in a group are in the same category (i.e., all in the same Achievement Level or all "Level 3 or Above"). An asterisk (*) appears when data are suppressed.
