<b>Implementation Date:</b> Fiscal Year 1988-89 July 1, 1988
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<b>Element Name:</b> <b>Transportation Category</b>	
<b>Definition/Domain</b>	
<p>The transportation category is a code which signifies the reason for the student being transported through either FEFP or local funding. Codes 1 through 4 and 6 are eligible for FEFP transportation funding; codes 5 and 0 are not.</p> <p>A separate transportation category should be kept for each <u>bus</u> or <u>bus route</u> the student rides.</p> <p><u>FEFP Fundable Transportation Codes</u></p> <p><b>1</b>      The student lives two or more miles from the school. (Section 236.083(1)(a), F.S.)</p> <p><b>2</b>      The student is a physically handicapped student (as defined by Rule 6A-1.0451(5), FAC) or is enrolled in a Teenage Parent program (Section 236.083(1)(b), F.S.) being transported to school, regardless of distance.</p> <p><b>3</b>      The student is a vocational or exceptional student being transported from one school center to another where appropriate programs are provided. Include dually enrolled students. (Section 236.083(1)(d), F.S.)</p> <p><b>4</b>      A KG-6 student living within two miles who is subject to appropriately verified hazardous walking conditions as reported to the Department of Education as stated in Section 234.021(3), F.S.</p> <p><b>6</b>      The student is participating in a Prekindergarten Early Intervention program (CS/CSHB 1593, 507 and 310 enrolled).</p> <p><u>Non-FEFP Fundable Transportation Codes</u></p> <p><b>5</b>      Nonphysically handicapped student transported less than two miles from home to school who does not meet the criteria for hazardous walking.</p> <p><b>0</b>      The student is transported, but none of the above categories applies. For example, if the district elects to provide transportation to and from a course which is non-FTE generating (whether it be from home to school or center to center), the district may not claim transportation funding.</p>
