<p>Withdrawal date is the calendar date of a PK-12 student's actual withdrawal from a school or district or an adult student's completion of or withdrawal from a course. See <u>Automated Student Attendance Recordkeeping</u> for procedures.</p> <p>For most adult students Withdrawal Date is not required on the permanent record. Vocational program completion date (the withdrawal date associated with a W28 withdrawal code) is required on the permanent record for adult postsecondary vocational program completers.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">MMDDYYYY Example: 06051983</p> <p>NOTE: 1. The latest withdrawal date will be reported in Survey 5 for all students in grades PK-12 and Adult.</p> <p>2. One occurrence of Withdrawal Code and Date has been added to the Category B portion of the automated student record (FIRN Print Program) for local district use. (Optional)</p> <p>3. The relationship of this element to Workforce Development Education is not known at this time. This element, therefore, is marked for <u>optional local use</u> concerning adult general education and postsecondary vocation education. If a change becomes necessary, you will be notified.</p>
