**Definition/Domain**

<b>D</b>	A secondary student in this program under an approved <b>Dropout Prevention</b> program and is receiving instruction using a modified curriculum or other program standards and/or under a teacher without the vocational certification specified for this program.
<b>E</b>	A secondary <b>exceptional</b> student (excluding gifted) mainstreamed in this program with modified outcomes and/or student performance standards. (NOTE: federal and state laws use terms 'disabled' and 'exceptional (excluding gifted)' interchangeably.)
or	
<b>S</b>	A member of a targeted population and is receiving this instruction in a <b>separate</b> class of such students.
or	
<b>M</b>	A member of a targeted population and is <b>mainstreamed</b> for this instruction.

P	Receiving instruction in a <b>pre-apprenticeship</b> program registered with the Florida Department of Labor and meeting the requirements of Rule 6A-6.077, FAC.
