Element Name: Educational Choice

Definition/Domain

The **primary** type of educational choice option, if any, that applies to the student's enrollment in the reported School Number, Current Enrollment. ←

CODE

DEFINITION

A → Controlled Open Enrollment (Public School Parental Choice) – 1002.31(1), F.S., a public education delivery system that allows school districts to make student school assignments using parents' indicated preferential school choice as a significant factor.

Note: This option does not require the district to provide transportation. A lottery procedure may be used by the school district to determine student assignment.

B → Special Program (Public School Parental Choice) - 1002.31(2), F.S., programs such as magnet, alternative school, special program, Advanced Placement, Advanced International Certificate, International Baccalaureate, and others.

C → Choice with Transportation - Transfer from a school that failed to make Adequate Yearly Progress for two or more consecutive years and has 'In Need of Improvement' status – Title I, Sec. 1116, ESEA.

Note: This option **must** include transportation for all eligible students with no restrictions or limitations with regard to capacity.

D Transfer from a Persistently Dangerous School - Title IX, Sec. 9532, ESEA.

→ **Note:** There are no schools in Florida designated as Dangerous Schools for the 2006-07 school year. No student should be coded with a "D".
