<b>E</b>	<b>Alternative to Expulsion Programs:</b> Programs designed for students who are subject to district school board policies for expulsion for repeated or serious offenders.
<b>P</b>	<b>Teenage Parent Programs:</b> Educational programs which are designed to provide a specialized curriculum and other services to meet the needs of students who are pregnant, students who are parents or babies of TAP students.
<b>D</b>	<b>Education Services in Department of Juvenile Justice Programs:</b> Educational programs provided to students participating in Department of Juvenile Justice prevention (diversion), detention, commitment programs, and Children In Need of Services (truant, ungovernable, and runaway) and other rehabilitation programs.
<b>N</b>	<b>Non-School Institution for Neglected or Delinquent Students</b> Student resides in a non-school institution for neglected or delinquent students as defined in Title I, Parts A and D of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act, as amended by Public Law 107-110. See the element Institution Number, Neglected /Delinquent for additional information.
<b>Z</b>	<b>Not Applicable.</b> Report code Z on the Federal/State Indicator record for all students in Survey Period 5.
