**Element Name: Title I Supplemental Educational Services – Achievement Goals Mastered**



**\*\*NEW ELEMENT\*\***

**Definition/Domain**

The number of Student Learning Plan (SLP) goals mastered by the student for the designated subject area during the reported term, as reflected in the final student progress report provided to the school district by the Supplemental Educational Services (SES) provider.

If the student is continuing to receive services after survey 3 state processing through May 1, the number of goals mastered should reflect the student's goals met by May 1.

Title I Supplemental Educational Services (TI SES) – Achievement Goals Mastered must be reported separately for each term, subject area, and service provider.

Examples:

- 03      The student mastered three achievement goals in Reading/Language Arts.
- 01      The student mastered one achievement goal in Mathematics.
- 00      The student did not master any achievement goals or the student did not receive services in the designated subject area. Also use code 00 for reporting in survey periods 2 and 9 for all TI SES students.
