

Attachment 3 – Summary of the Business Rules for the District Industry Certification Allocation for 2015-16

Three categories of industry certifications are included in the calculation:

- Eligible Category 1: Certifications reported on the final 2014-15 WDIS submission that were eligible for funding but not included in the 2014-15 funding allocation
- Eligible Category 2: Certifications reported on the 2015-16 WDIS Survey F and W matched to students enrolled in 2014-15 in the same program in which the certification was reported
- Eligible Category 3: Certifications reported on the final 2015-16 WDIS system matched to students enrolled in 2015-16 in the same program in which the certification was reported

¹ Example 1: Student with 2 certifications not linked to 15-16 DOL is capped at 1 fundable

Example 2: Students with 2 certifications linked to DOL and 1 not linked to DOL would have all three certifications included in the calculation.
