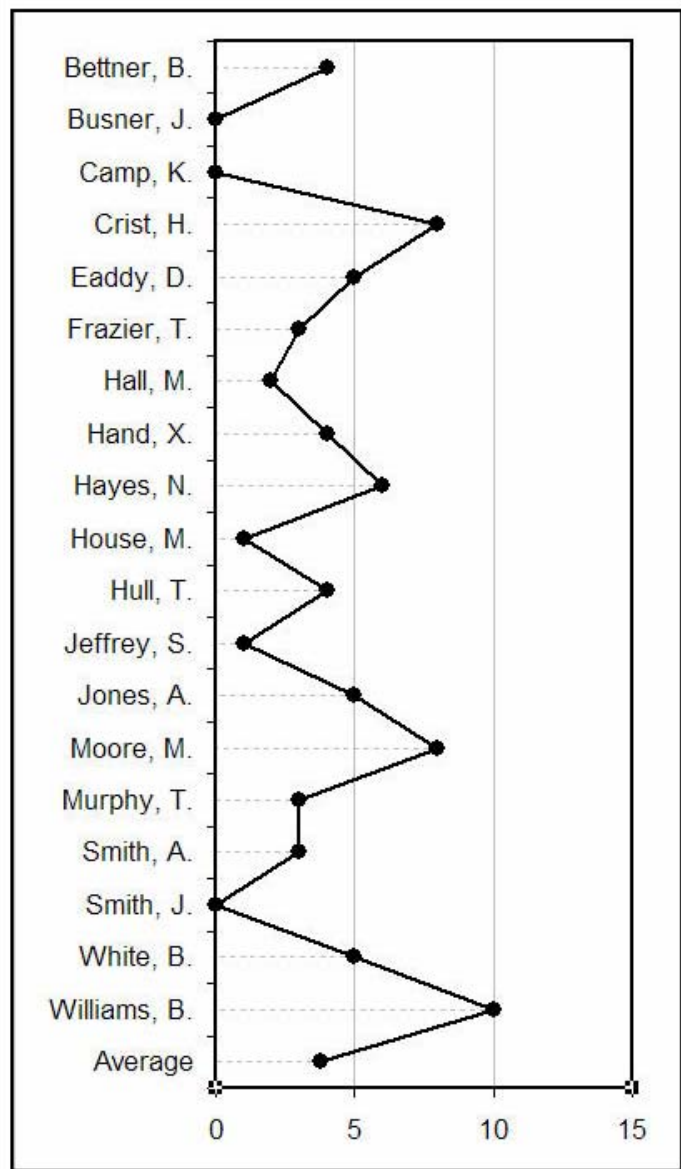

Enhanced Instruction

Instructional strategies can be classified as one or more of the following:

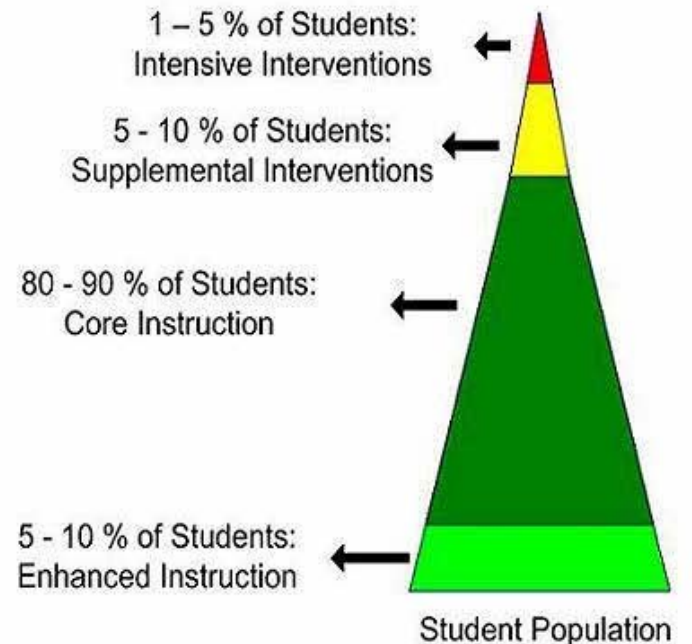
Intensive Interventions - Provide to children who are not responding to Supplemental Interventions and who need additional diagnostic assessments. Typically includes one-to-one instruction, and frequent progress monitoring. Designed to meet the needs of 1-5% of the class.

Supplemental Interventions - Provided to children who are not responding to the Core Instruction. Typically includes small group instruction, specialized materials, and more time; must include frequent progress monitoring; designed to meet the needs of 5-10% of the class.

Core Instruction - Provided to children achieving on-grade level; must be provided to all children and is designed to meet the needs of 80-90% of the class.

Enhanced Instruction - Provided to children achieving above grade level in addition to Core Instruction; designed to meet the needs of 5-10% of the class.

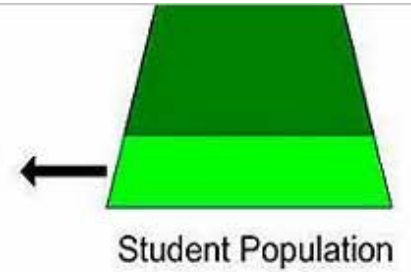
Academic Intervention and Instruction
