Our Professional Development Plan:

Typically, programs elect to begin with on-site training. Florida programs may wish to consider a variation on the site training option and choose regional training, where multiple programs can benefit from one convenient location. Workshops are capped at 35 participants (minimum 20), and each participant must bring their OWL kit. Follow-up training is offered on-site, via Web cast or phone, and self-directed with the professional development DVD and booklet that are included in the OWL kit. The DVD offers seven hours of easily navigable section overviews by OWL author Judy Schickedanz, lesson goals, teaching vignettes and review sessions.

FL VPK Implementation - The implementation workshop, “Learning to Use OWL,” prepares participants to implement all elements of OWL. This 3-day workshop (20 – 35 participants) covers early literacy research, OWL philosophy, all components of the curriculum, and includes hands-on activities for better understanding. It also provides strategies for introducing OWL to colleagues and parents. This workshop is designed for programs seeking comprehensive training in the OWL curriculum. In addition to the basic implementation training, participants will learn how to modify curriculum for special education populations, incorporate pre-k math curriculum, and link assessment to instruction.
