The Saxon Regional Consultant team consists of two National Consultant Managers and nine Regional Consultants. The primary goal for the Regional Consultant team is to ensure proper implementation of Saxon products throughout a school or district.

Before Implementation

- Your PreKindergarten Textbook Coordinator will meet with the Saxon Educational Representative to work out dates, times, locations, and duration of inservices for your district.
- A training team consisting of Saxon consultants or per diems teachers who have taught Saxon products and have been certified as inservice providers, will be utilized. They will initiate original inservice training and maintain ongoing support for the internal staff that will remain as support for individual buildings.

Implementation-Beginning of the School Year

- An implementation inservice will be scheduled near the beginning of the school year. The implementation inservice will be conducted for all teachers as identified by your district. These sessions will last around three hours.

Administrator Training

- All administrators will also receive training to facilitate the successful implementation of the program at their sites.

Implementation-During the School Year

- Additional follow-up inservices can be scheduled through your Educational Representative, later in the year. The follow-up days serve to reassure teachers and teacher trainers as to the accuracy of their understanding of our methodology, and to answer questions that they may have at the time of the inservice. Follow-up inservices can be made available through Live Meetings via the website or consultant visits.
- Our consultants are available throughout the year for individual school or classroom visits. One method many administrators favor is to have a Saxon consultant visit, and observe classroom instruction (with the teacher trainer) and offer suggestions. It is imperative that an administrator attends the follow-up meeting.
- Depending on the size of the district and their individual needs, consultant support may vary. Therefore, frequency of consultant visits is solely dependent on each individual district.
