

# STATE REQUIREMENTS FOR EDUCATIONAL FACILITIES (SREF) 2007 ADMISSIONS APPLICATION

## Overview

The Florida Department of Education, Office of Educational Facilities, offers a Continuing Education (CE) course in the State Requirements for Educational Facilities (SREF) and the Florida Building Code (FBS) Section 423 to qualified individuals.

The purpose of this course is to provide education and knowledge of Florida's School Laws, updates and changes to the FBC, Section 423, Chapter 1013 of the Florida Statutes (FS) and to the State Requirements for Educational Facilities (SREF) for public educational facilities construction (Rule 6-2.001, Florida Administrative Code (FAC)).

Licensed participants will receive 23 CEH's upon successful completion of the course. The CEH's are valid for two years.

There is no cost or fees to applicants, but classes are limited to 40 participants.

## Who Should Attend?

Any individuals having responsibility for designing, plan review, or conducting construction inspections of educational facilities and enforcing the Florida Building Code and the State Requirements for Educational Facilities should attend this course.

Architects, Engineers, General, and Subcontractors, Building Code Administrators, Licensed Inspectors, and Building Inspectors are required to maintain continuing education credits for license renewal every two years. DBPR approved sponsor number is #0001023. The Construction Industry Licensing Board's approval number is #0008367. The Board of Architecture and Interior Design list this as an advanced course, approval number AR-01.299. Florida Building Code Administrators and Inspection Board approval number is 0006993. Florida Board of Professional Engineers continuing education provide number is 51. A Total of 23 Continuing Education Hours have been granted. The state Fire Marshal's office has granted the course 8 CEH's.
