## FEDERAL/STATE INDICATOR STATUS - REJECT RULES

Edit 16 deleted 1/5/10.

 16. Deleted 1/5/10. If Grade Level is not PK and if Survey Period Code is 3 or 5 and if the Master School Identification file shows School in Need of Improvement (SINI) Status other than Z, 0 or 1 for the School Number, Current Enrollment, then NCLB Option, Choice with Transportation must be code C or D. —record rejected—

### EXAMPLE

The first record listed below would pass the edit. The second record would be rejected because the School in Need of Improvement (SINI) Status code is 4 and the NCLB Option, Choice with Transportation on the Federal/State Indicator Status record is not C or D.

### ~~DISTRICT RESPONSIBILITY~~

If the rejected record should not have been submitted, no action is required. However, if the district wishes the data in the rejected record to be loaded to the data base, the district must correct the NCLB Option, Choice with Transportation code and resubmit the record.

## STUDENT COURSE SCHEDULE - REJECT RULES

 39. If Survey Period is 2 or 3 and School Number, Current Instruction/Service is 7001 (district virtual instruction program) or 7004 (franchise of Florida Virtual School), then FTE Earned, Course must be 0000. -record rejected-

### EXAMPLE

The third and fourth records below would be loaded to the data base assuming no other reject rule would cause their rejection. The first and second records below which are marked with an asterisk would be rejected because the FTE Earned, Course is not zero.

If the rejected records should not have been submitted, no action is required. However, if the district wishes the data in the rejected records to be loaded to the data base, the district must correct the School Number, Current Instruction/Service or the FTE Earned, Course and resubmit the records.
