

APPENDIX H

Notifying EDS that Transmission of a File is Complete/ Requesting a Report during the State Processing Window

XMITFINI

Once the file has been successfully transmitted, it is necessary to notify Educational Data Systems (EDS). Do this by executing a procedure at NWRDC named XMITFINI in DPS.DISTRICT.PROCLIB.

PLEASE NOTE: It is necessary to use the same job setup as you used to transmit your original data. Change only the execute line(s) to execute XMITFINI and omit the //INPUT DD * line.

In each instance,	ACCT	account number was previously assigned
	PPPP	password for the account
	NNN	is the node name (e.g. NWR, NER)
	YY	is the remote ID for your RJE terminal emulator. The person who set up the emulator will know this number. Use 0 (zero) if your site is a JES2 or PNET node, or just specify NNN.
	TT	is your district number.
	GG	is = GQ for Student or is = GU for Staff or is = JU for WDIS formats.
	FFFFFF	is the file number defined in Appendix M,
	F00000	is used to print all Validation reports or all Exception reports (used with TTTT=VALIDATE, XCEPTION)
	yyyy	is the current fiscal year (i.e., 8788)

SURVEY is the survey for which the data are being transmitted for STUDENT, STAFF and WDIS formats.(i.e., 2 = October).

TTTT = INITIAL for initial edit or
 = BATCH for batch update file
 = VALIDATE for validation or validation/exception report
 = XCEPTION for an exception report
 = ERRLIST for the error list
 = FILE for files listed in Appendix M or the on-line Reports for Request Screen

XMITFINR

In order to notify Educational Data Systems of your request for a report, you must execute a job at NWRDC named XMITFINR in DPS.DISTRICT.JCL. This job uses a procedure named XMITFINR which can be found in DPS.DISTRICT.PROCLIB.

	TT GG	is your district number. is = GQ for Student or is = GU for Staff or is = JU for WDIS formats.

FFFFFF	is the file number defined in Appendix M or the on-line Reports for Request Screen
F00000	is used to print all Validation reports or all Exception reports (used with TTTT=VALIDATE, XCEPTION)
yyyy	is the current fiscal year (i.e., 8788)
SURVEY	is the survey for which the data are being transmitted for STUDENT, STAFF and WDIS formats (i.e., 2 = October). Leave blank for FINANCE formats.
TTTT	= INITIAL for initial edit = BATCH for batch update file = VALIDATE for validation report = XCEPTION for exception report = REPORT for other reports = FILE for files listed in the on-line Reports for Request Screen
*SSSS	school number (may be a specific 4-digit number or 0000 for all schools)
*F	FTE indicator (L for less than 0.5, G for greater than 0.5 and A for all students)

*Replace SSSS and F with desired school number and FTE indicator for the Student Course Listing (F62124) and Teacher Class Listing (F62125). Other reports do not require these parameters. You may delete the line that contains SSSSF or leave that line in the job stream.
