2007-08 Annual Change in Fall Enrollment from 2006-07

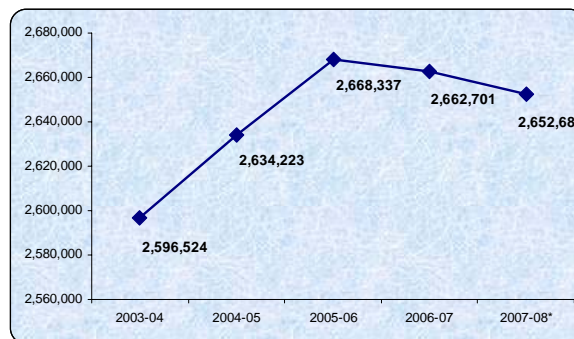

Membership in Florida's Public Schools, Fall 2007

This brief provides information on PK-12 membership in Florida's public schools. Figure 1 shows the enrollment trend for the last five years. However, Florida's PK-12 membership has shown an annual decline for the past two years.

The fall 2007 total prekindergarten through twelfth grade student membership was 2,652,684 for Florida's public schools. When compared to the fall 2003 membership of 2,596,524, the fall 2007 membership showed an increase of 56,160 students or 2.16 percent. Of the 47 regular districts that showed increases in membership during the same period, the greatest percentage increase occurred in Flagler County (49.16 percent). During the past year (2006-07 to 2007-08), more than half (38) of Florida's 67 regular school districts experienced a decline in member
