## Introduction

The Office of Education Information and Accountability Services publishes this document annually to provide an abstract of statistical information covering the field of education in Florida school districts. This volume includes a selection of data from several surveys conducted by the Department of Education in addition to summarized information from legislatively mandated reports. Data appearing in this publication was compiled from the department's automated student and staff databases in March 2008. The High School Graduation data was compiled in February 2008.

The information contained in this publication includes student demographic information by grade, program enrollment for exceptional student education, disciplinary actions, counts for dropouts and graduates, dropout rates and graduation rates, non-promotions, other special program data, FCAT results, staff characteristics, selected staff ratios, average principals' salaries, average teachers' salaries, number of schools by type, class-size averages by grade range, and distribution of school grades.

Results for these indicators are shown for each of Florida's 67 regular school districts (presented in alphabetical order) as well as additional special districts comprising developmental research schools and other schools that serve special populations.
