Report Headings:

Total Individuals is a unique count of individuals.

Initial Employed is a unique count of individuals found employed also expressed as a percentage of Total Individuals.

Earnings Levels as Pcnt of All Employed is the unique number of individuals employed divided by Total Individuals. Earnings levels calculated as 40 hrs per week x 13 weeks per qtr x hourly wage.

Level 0 – Quarterly wages less than minimum wage, \$2678.

Level 1 – Quarterly wages of at least minimum wage and less than or equal to \$3900

Level 2 – Quarterly wages greater than \$3900 and less than or equal \$4680.

Level 3 – Quarterly wages greater than \$4680.

Cont Employment is the percentage of Total Individuals that continued their employment in the year(s) shown.

Initial Avg Qtrly Earn is the average wage for all employed individuals.

Earnings Growth is the change in wages for the year(s) shown.

Publ Assist is the percentage of Total Individuals that received public assistance in the form of cash assistance or food stamps.

Cont Publ Assist is the percentage of Total Individuals that received public assistance in the years shown.

Cont Education is the percentage of Total Individuals that were enrolled in public or private education.

Notes:

The statewide TIER I is an unduplicated report by social security number and will be less than the sum of the strategies in TIER II which is unduplicated by social security number within a strategy. Likewise, the sum of the strategies will be less than the sum of the programs in TIER III, which is unduplicated by social security number within a program.

The Wagner Peyser sub-components will sum to greater than the program total because an individual is counted for each Wagner Peyser setting in which he is found. The Wagner-Peyser program is broken into its parts at the end of each TIER III section.

Performance data is for only those individuals with valid social security numbers.
