Request for Applications for Supplemental Educational Services Providers for the 2008-2009 School Year

Summary: Attached is the Request for Applications for the annual approval of providers of supplemental educational services (SES). Section 1008.331, Florida Statutes, (supplemental educational services in Title I schools.--) requires that each provider begin serving students by October 15, 2008.

In order to apply to become an SES provider in Florida, each applicant must submit the on-line application and mail or hand deliver hard-copy documents and original signed assurances. The on-line application, instructions for this process, and other technical assistance materials are available on the Bureau of Public School Options' website at <http://www.fldoe.org/flbpso/>. Please read the instructions carefully before completing the application. It is recommended that you save a copy of your application responses in an electronic word processing document prior to making entries on the on-line system.

The on-line application must be submitted by 5:00 p.m. Eastern Standard Time on Friday, March 3, 2008. Additionally, all applicants must mail or hand deliver the Cover Page, Checklist of Hard-Copy Documentation Requirements, Financial Soundness Documentation, and original signed assurances on Attachment A: General Assurances and Attachment B: Internet Statement of Assurances to the Department. These required documents must be received by the Bureau of Public School Options at the address indicated below no later than 5:00 p.m. Eastern Standard Time on Friday, March 3, 2008.
