What Is First Book?

Is My Program Eligible?

Your program must meet two basic requirements to register with First Book: Your program must predominantly serve children from low-income families; and your program must not discriminate based on race, gender, sexual orientation, national origin, religion or physical or mental disability.

Register online at www.firstbook.org/register. Registration is free and takes just a few minutes. Once registered, you will have access to all First Book resources for free or deeply discounted new books.
