Your child *may* qualify for **free** academic assistance through the Supplemental Educational Services Program (SES), a part of the *No Child Left Behind Act* of 2001.

SES helps students catch up in important subjects like reading, language arts, and mathematics. The services may include tutoring, after-school classes, weekend classes, or summer classes.

How would my child qualify?

1. Your child attends a Title I school that has not made Adequate Yearly Progress for two or more consecutive years, **and**
2. Your child qualifies for free or reduced-price lunch
