

Figure 1. 2005 Reading Scores- Percentage of Students Scoring Level 3 and Above by Grade Level

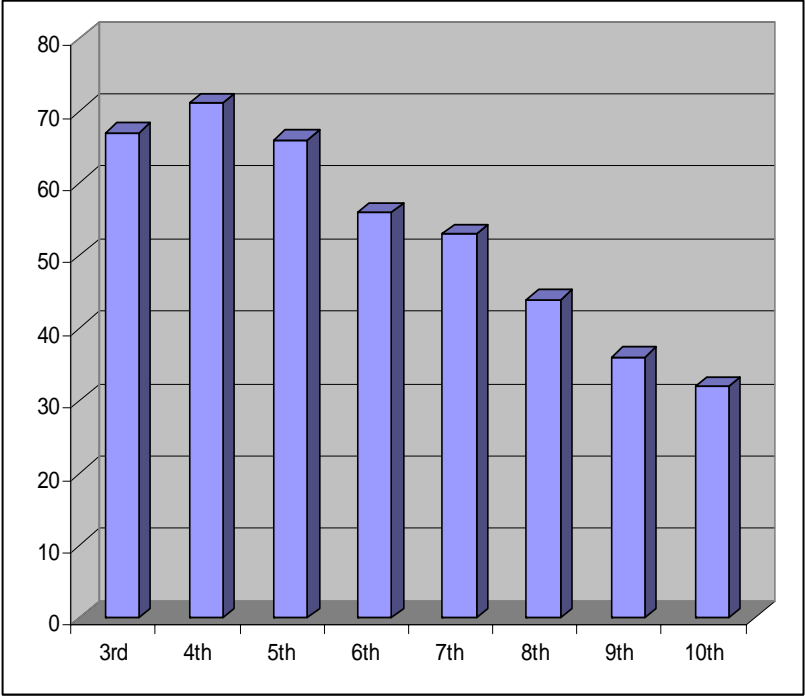


Figure 2. 2005 Mathematics Scores- Percentage of Students Scoring Level 3 and Above by Grade Level

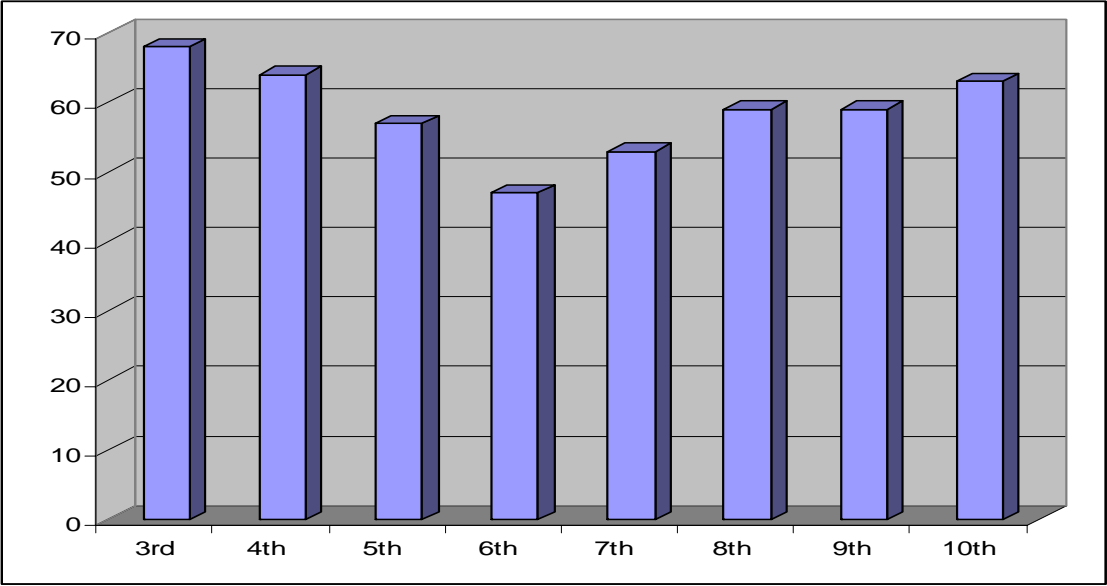


Figure 3. Percent of Students Retained Statewide by Grade 2003-04

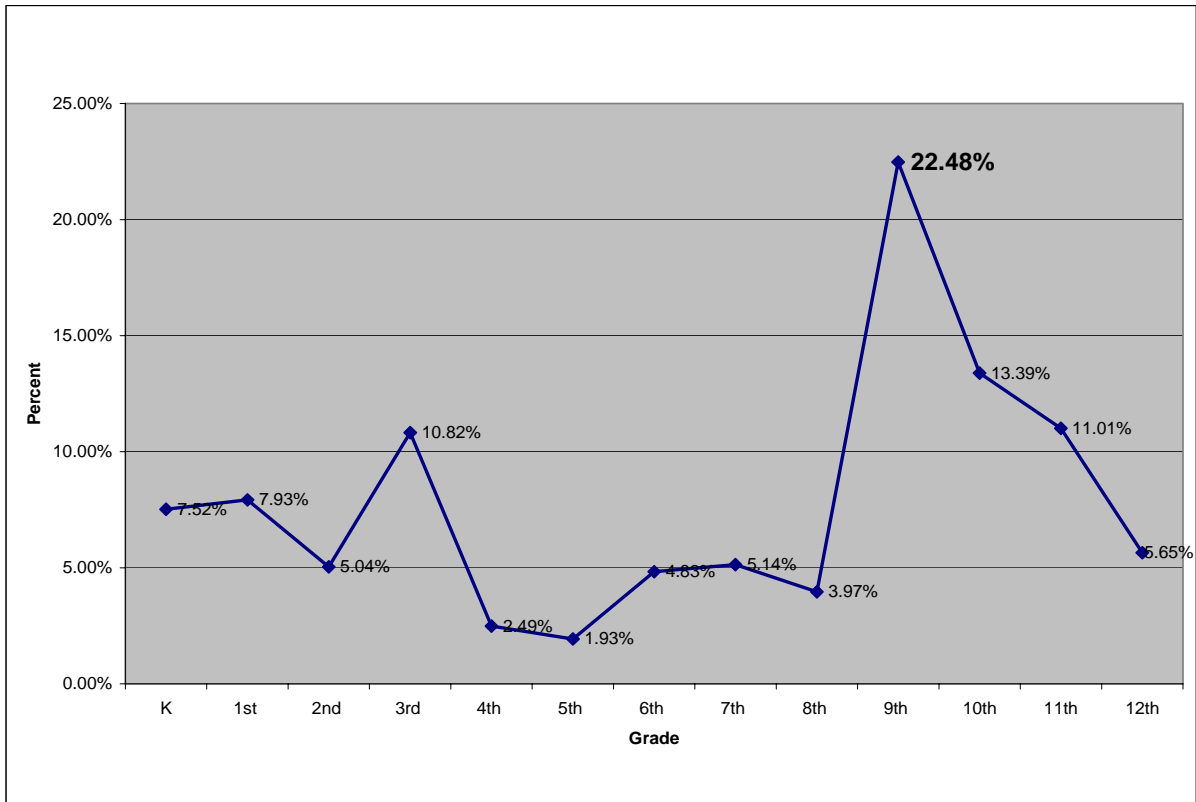


Figure 4. Florida High School Graduation Rates by Race, 1998-99 to 2003-04

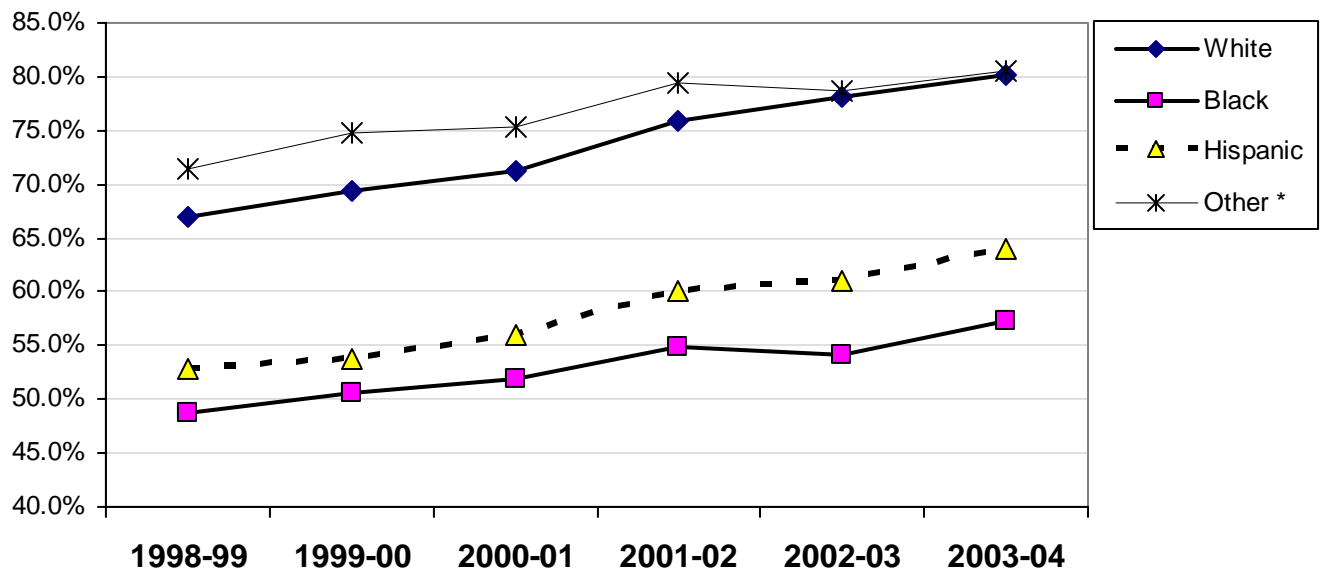


Figure 5. Percent of Students Who Require Remediation at the Postsecondary Level

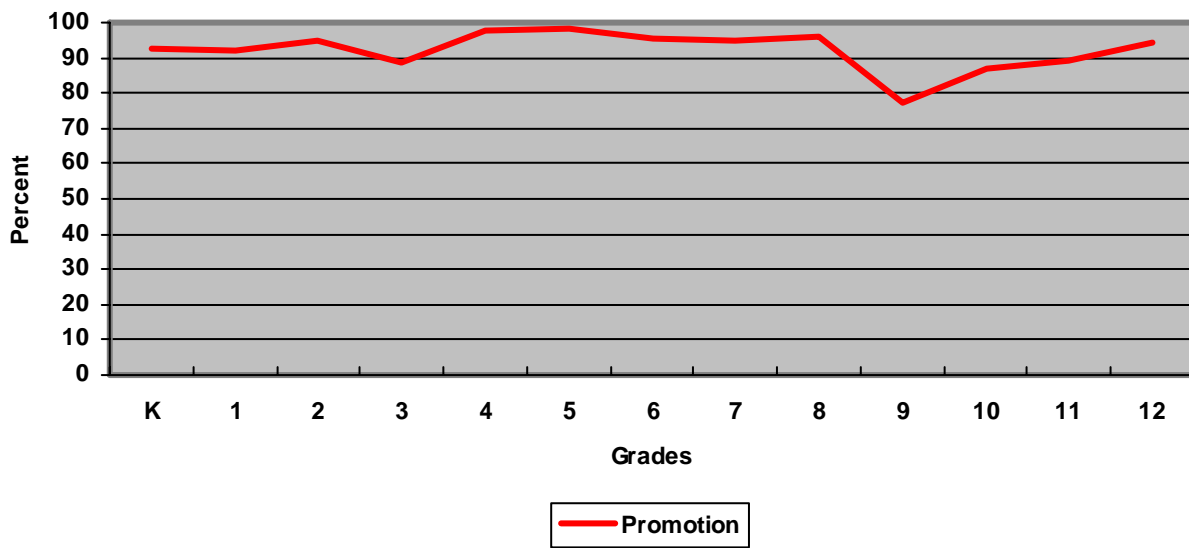


Figure 7. Number of 9th Graders Retained from 1997-2004
