Official Rules and Guidelines

Governor Charlie Crist's Hispanic Heritage Month Excellence in Education Award Contest is open to all Hispanic, fulltime educators in an elementary, middle or high school in Florida. Three winners will be selected: one elementary (K-5) teacher, one middle (6-8) teacher and one high school (9-12) teacher. Winners will be notified the week of October 6, 2008.

- Completed nomination forms must be mailed to Executive Office of the Governor: Excellence in Education Award Committee, 400 S. Monroe Street, Suite LL-10, Tallahassee, Florida 32399, **post-marked by Wednesday, October 1, 2008.**
- Nominations may be submitted by a principal, teacher, parent or student.
- Winners will receive a check for \$1,500. Winners will be presented their award at the Governor's Hispanic Heritage Month celebration to be held in Tallahassee in October. All travel and lodging expenses will be paid for the winners and one immediate family member.
