As a single school, school district, PKY DRS does not have the same paperwork issues that occur in regular school districts. We do not have district required reporting and other routine communication matters that occur between district offices, area offices, and the schools.

Our focus has been on using technology to eliminate the need for traditional paperwork tasks. Our K-12 Leadership Team (team leaders and department chairs) provide the input and leadership for this endeavor. Our technology coordinator provides the technical assistance and necessary professional development for implementation. The following list identifies what we have in place at this time.

- On Line Parent Handbook/Parent News Letters and Daily Announcements
- Phone Home to Parents
- Extensive use of email between parents, teachers, administrators, students
- Online textbook access for secondary math teachers and students
- IEP and EP plans online – locally developed (Gibco software)

We are currently working to develop an online program for our 504 Plans.
